5. Offense description: I was the "Getaway Driver" for a string of armed robberies committed by myself and 3 co-defendants. During one of the robberies a store clerk was accidentally shot and killed by my brother who is one of my co-defendants. I was sentenced to 100 yrs for being (PTAC) sentencing is consecutive.
6. Length of sentence: 100 yrs.
7. Current Prison: Fox Lake Corr. Inst.
8. MR/PMR Date: 1/11/2062
9. Original parole eligibility date: 1/11/21
10. Programs taken: AODA level 5, Anger Management, Cognitive Thinking (CBIP), Restorative Justice, Cabinet Making and Millworking Certificate from Moraine Park College. Forklift operators Certificate.

Greetings!

My name is Wayne E. Hollins JR. #313225
I am the eldest of two sons. My younger brother
is also one of my co-defendants. I was convicted
and sentenced to 100 yrs. for my role as the "Getaway
Driver" during a string of Armed Robberies the night
of November 26, 1995. I was 21 yrs. old at the
time. My co-defendants were 18, 18 and 17. I have
served 23 yrs. of the 100 yrs sentence I received.
I still have 2 yrs. until I see the parole board
for the first time. I have NO remaining program
needs. My behavior history is excellent. Basically,
I am doing dead time. At the time of my arrest,
I had no prior criminal history, no juvenile record,
High school graduate, College attendee 1 1/2 yrs. at the
UW-Oshkosh. Due to my co-defendants and my
consecutive sentencing, we are currently serving more
time than people who were convicted of 1st Degree
Intentional Homicide. The system is flawed when
you served less time for murdering someone than you
do for being the "Getaway Driver" for a string of Armed
Robberies and a Felony Murder?

My charges are:

(3) Counts Armed Robbery (PTAC) 40 yrs, 25 yrs, 20 yrs.

(1) Count Att. Armed Robbery (PTAC) 15 yrs. = 100 yrs

(1) Count Felony Murder (PTAC) 50 yrs. (concurrent) 5
